The composer, James Olsen, has based his work "Twilight of the Beggars" on John Gay's "The Beggar's Opera" (1728), which 200 years later inspired Berthold Brecht and Kurt Weill to write the "Dreigroschenoper". John Gay wrote "The Beggar's Opera" at Douglas House, a grade II listed building where the administration of The German School London is located today.
